General Information

Sundays Our Family Service begins at 10.30am every Sunday morning and we also have a prayer meeting that all are welcome to attend which runs on the ground floor, in the lounge, at 9.45am every Sunday.

Morning Tea is held on the ground floor in the lounge and reception area after the service. Please stay and join us.

Babies Space is available on the ground floor in the lounge with toys and books etc. suitable for young, supervised children during the service. There is also a change table available in the toilet off the kitchenette on the ground floor.

'Spratz'—Kids Church is Sunday School for children aged 2-12 (Kindergarten age and School Years 1-8). This takes place each Sunday during school terms and is announced part way through the service. Their meeting room is on the second floor.

If you are visiting with us and have children, they are welcome to join our programmes or stay in the service with you.

Toilet Facilities are located off the main corridor on the first floor.

Community Ministries This operates Monday to Friday 9.00am to 12 noon and 2.00pm to 5.00pm each week and includes our foodbank (*Mondays, Wednesdays, Fridays 10am-12 Noon*) advocacy, counselling, budgeting and general support for the community.

Cellgroups (Bible Studies) meet fortnightly and run during school terms. Please contact Karen or Shaun for more details.

Kafe Kids—Playgroup is FREE and runs during the school terms on Tuesday mornings from 10:00-11.30am on the first floor. All pre-school aged children and caregivers are welcome.

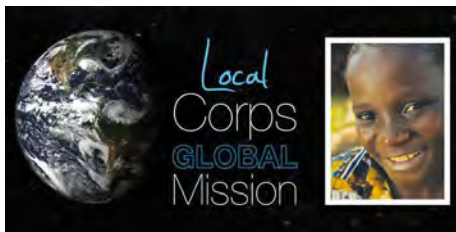
