

Setting Up Our Family Christmas Tree Party



### Begin a new family tradition:

This pack is designed to help you as a family take a moment, as you adorn your family Christmas tree, to dedicate this season of Advent to the adoration of Christ. As we spend the Christmas season focusing on Jesus, we help our lovely ones get excited about the Greatest Gift they've every received: Jesus!

As you plan and host your Adorn & Adore: Setting Up Our Family Christmas Tree Party, we pray that it will be both a dawn and a door - a beginning and an entry point - into a season of fresh discovery of God's gifts and presence evident every day, in every season.

### INCLUDED IN THIS PACK:

### Before the party:

- 1. Print invitations and personalise them with your party details plus the invitees' names.

  Distribute these to your family members, plus anyone outside of your household you'd like to invite.
- 2. Print out the resources in this pack:
  - a. Printable bunting
  - b. Sign for your box of tree ornaments and decorations
  - c. Family Prayer for gathering around your Christmas tree (enough copies for everyone)
  - d. Tag for your Adorn & Adore box
- 3. Gather supplies needed:
  - a. Your family Christmas tree and ornaments, twinkly lights, etc.
  - b. Supplies for your Adorn & Adore box (see page 12 for suggestions and ideas)
  - c. Ingredients to make Homemade Rocky Road popcorn (or another treat your family would enjoy)

### For the party:

- 1. Hang up bunting and decorate (decorate as much or as little as you'd like)
- 2. Prepare your Adorn & Adore box (see page 12 for instructions)
- 3. Prepare and lay out some sweet treats, ie. the Rocky Road popcorn and/or whatever else you've planned
- 4. Set up the bare Christmas tree and attach the printed sign to your box of tree ornaments

### At the party:

Serve sweet treats, play some Christmas music (can we suggest this playlist?!), open your Adorn & Adore box, decorate your family Christmas tree, read the Family Prayer together, and share in the excitement of Christmas when we remember the story of Jesus' birth, and our birth into His family tree.

### Instructions for making your own party bunting:


Print the next five pages and then cut around each shape.

Punch holes in the top corners of each, then thread a long piece of twine, string or thin ribbon through the holes.



Hang your bunting somewhere it will be seen by everyone at the party, perhaps alongside your Christmas tree,


You might also like to add a strand of twinkly lights and/or other garland, ribbon, etc.


















# Rocky Road Popcorn Recipe

### Ingredients:

popcorn, dark chocolate, marshmallows
plus any extras you have on hand/would like to include:
 dried fruit (eg. cranberries, apricots, cherries)
 nuts (eg. almonds, peanuts, cashews)
 jelly lollies

### Method:

Pop your popcorn (in the microwave or machine, or on the stove!). Cut up your marshmallows and any other extras into small bite size pieces.

Melt your dark chocolate.

Mix everything up in a large bowl, then pop in a lined tray.

Put in the fridge to set. When firm, break up into bite size pieces.

Store in an air-tight container in the fridge.

### Fill a box (or bag) with these special items for your

- A candle to light as part of your gathering, and throughout Advent
  - Christmas Pyjamas for your kiddos
  - Jesse Tree ornaments to assemble and add to the tree (these printable ones from Scripture Union are beautiful!)




This Christmas, we will tell the story of Jesus' birth and celebrate that this is our story too – the story of our birth into Your family, the family of Christ. Amen.
