# MAKE THIS YOUR BEST EASTER YET...

Easter is one of the most popular times for people to visit church. Here are some of our top tips for making it as impacting as possible:

- *PLAN:* What would work best to connect with people in your area? Consider a family fun day (like a café or Easter egg hunt), a service with more creative elements, a modern stations of the cross event, or a 'sunrise' service with a BBQ of fish and bread at the beach.
- CAST VISION: One of the keys to a successful weekend is getting your congregation on board. Cast vision early for your Easter weekend and convince people of the 'why'—why are you doing this and why you need their help.
- *BRANDING:* Give people the tools to invite people. There are a range of free Easter graphics online to make your branding professional/engaging. Remember to utilise tools like Facebook and Eventbrite, and give people flyers/posters to distribute.

- ON THE DAY: Think about visitors in all you do—what they need to know to be comfortable, how your room looks, and the language you use. Walk through your venue before with 'visitor eyes' and tidy, let visitors know how long your service/event is and where facilities are, and remember their experience begins in the car park!
- FOLLOW UP: Without follow-up, a great service or event might be a one-off for people. Figure out a strategy for follow-up—how will you gather details from visitors to allow you to follow up? What is your next 'thing' you will invite them to?
