


God made me amazing!


Fill in the map with places you like to go. Where do you like to eat? Play? Shop? As you create your map, think about the promise that God is always with you, wherever you go.

What would you like to say to that person? Write them a letter in the space below or draw a picture of you together.






Psalm 28:7 says the Lord is our SHIELD.

Design your own shield using words, pictures & symbols that remind you that the Lord is our strength and we can trust Him.


