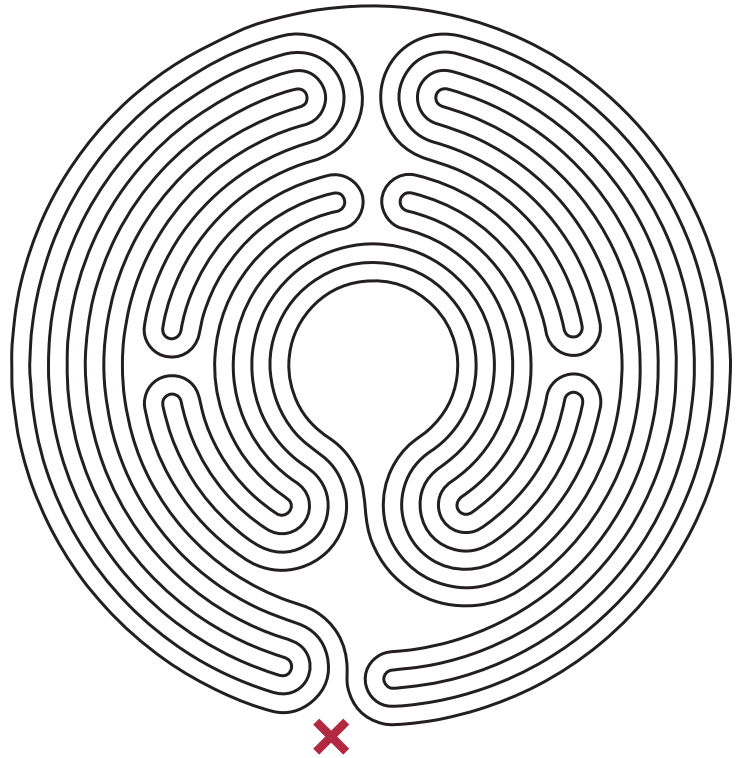

The Labyrinth

The labyrinth shown on the activity sheet is one of 270 designed by Mark Wallinger and installed by Transport in London in underground stations throughout their network. Every one is a different design, but all are in black on white and feature a red cross marking the entry point.

Pictured right is another example.

The labyrinth is a traditional symbol of the spiritual journey, there is a particularly famous one at Chartres Cathedral, in France. Many have been created in recent times often in a garden or park, sometimes with stones or paving, sometimes by mowing the design into a lawn. There are many ways to walk the labyrinth as a meditation or prayer.

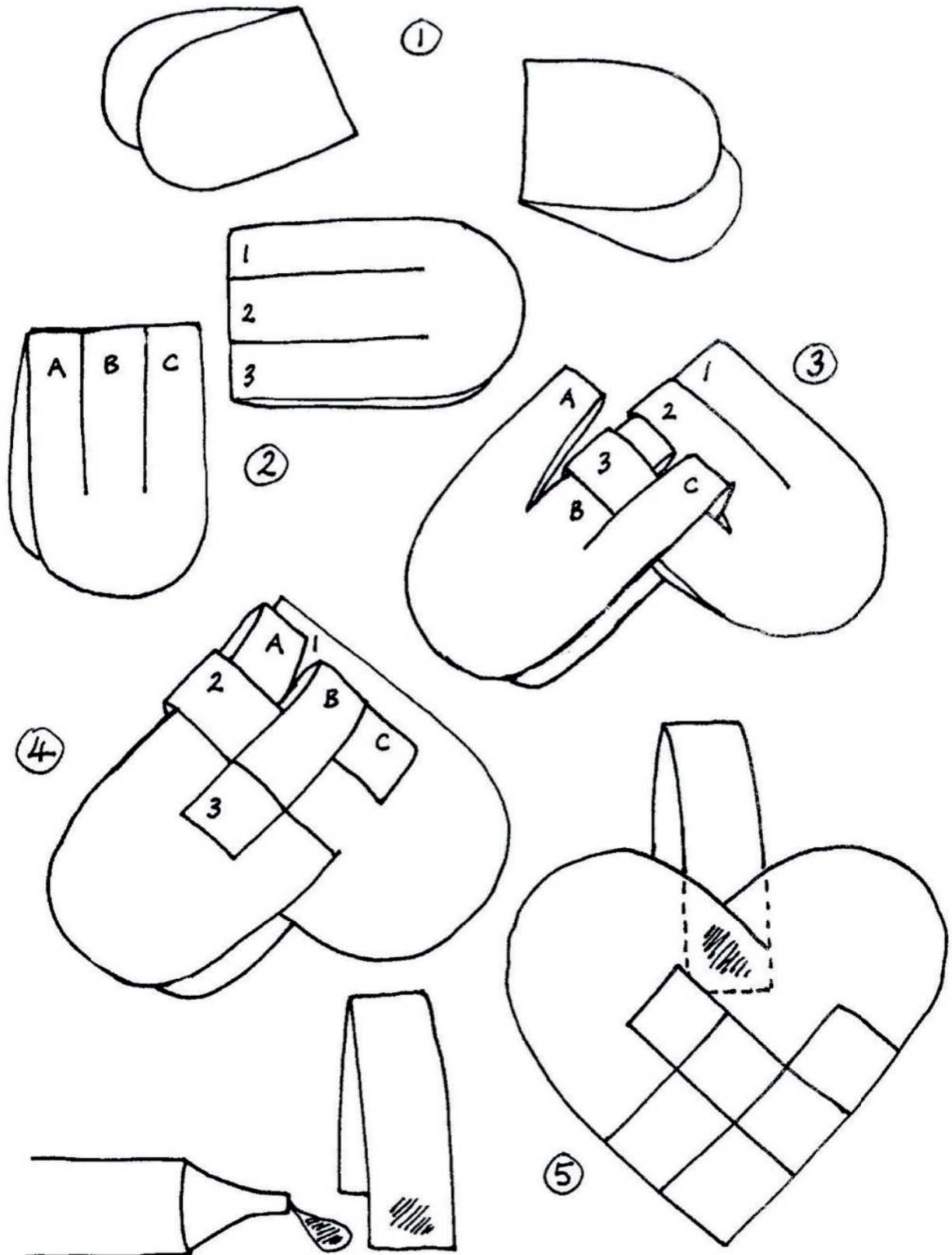
Materials needed: Coloured paper, scissors and glue.

To make the basket:

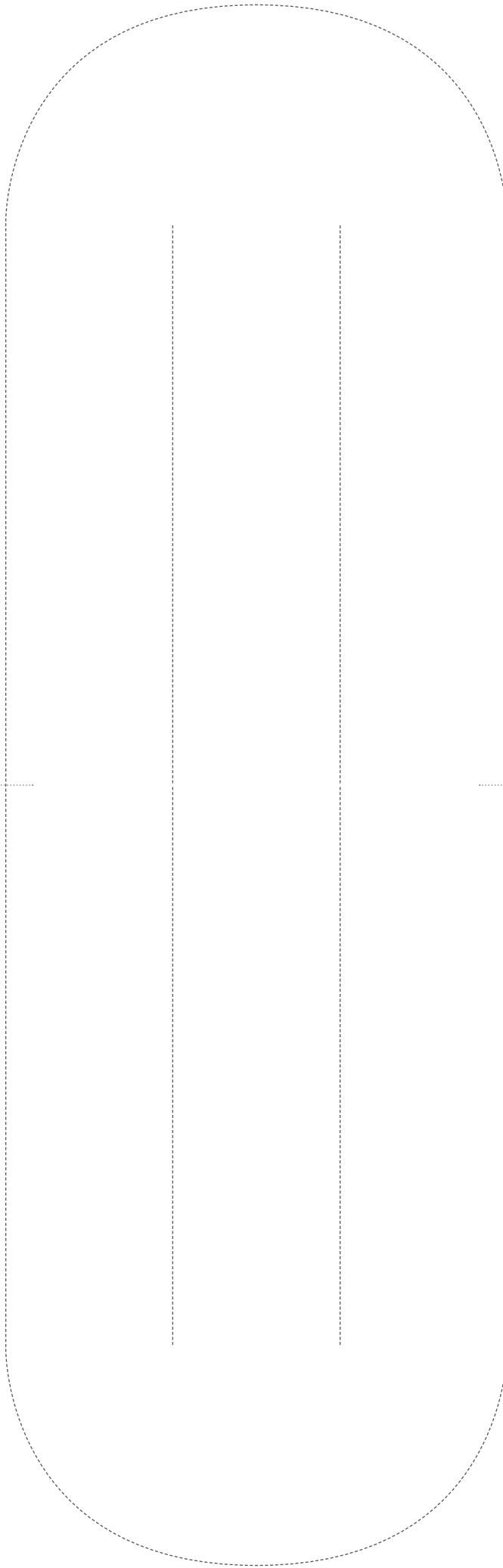
Steps 1 & 2: Fold the template in half and then cut out the shapes along the dotted lines.
