Rules of Online Engagement

During the open times of prayer everybody will be invited to participate in the conversations and prayers. These can be in any language.

Please follow these guidelines

- Microphones needs to be muted unless sharing/praying and must be muted during the online content.
- If attending as part of a group, the person speaking needs to come close to the microphone to be heard clearly.
- We encourage you to have the video on so that we can see the groups involved.
- The chat function at the side will be available all the time

Scripture & Theme for the Weekend

Our theme for the Summit is “Strong Foundations – Growing in Faith”

Ephesians 3:17b – 19 NLT

“Your roots will grow down into God’s love and keep you strong. ¹⁸ And may you have the power to understand, as all God’s people should, how wide, how long, how high, and how deep his love is. ¹⁹ May you experience the love of Christ, though it is too great to understand fully. Then you will be made complete with all the fullness of life and power that comes from God.”

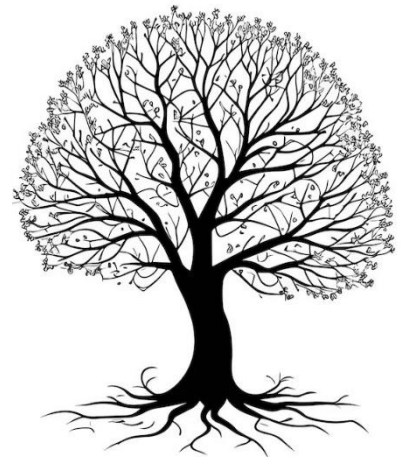
Art Installation Leaves

We have included on our Compass page an outline of a leaf (Appendix 1). We encourage you to print some of these out (preferably onto green paper) for each person attending so that they can write prayers, Scripture, draw and express their thoughts during the Summit. This can be on both sides of the leaf. We would as that you then gather them up and send them to either THQ/DHQ or RHQ. We are hoping to use these as part of a prayer Art Installation at a Territorial event in the near future.

Off-Line Activity Friday Night at 8pm

Tree drawing Roots, Trunk, Branches & Leaves/foliage

Get people attending to draw a tree on a piece of paper. Ensure that included on the drawing are all parts of the tree roots, trunk, branches and leaves/foliage (see example to the right). A simple black pen or pencil line will be perfect. Using different colour pens or pencils ask people to write down among the different part of their tree the following things



- In the **Roots**
 - The foundations they have in their life
 - The foundations that faith is built on
 - What foundations they want to grow more in their lives
- In the **Trunk & Branches**
 - What is helping you grow in your prayer life?
 - Where do you see growth in your spiritual life and prayer life?
 - What other things might you need to do to grow?
- In the **Leaves & Foliage**
 - What fruit is currently evident in your life?
 - What fruit would you like to develop more of?
 - What prayer and spiritual practices do you need to cultivate to achieve this.

Once this has been done get people to gather in groups of 3 – 4 and pray generally for the growth of each person.

This could also be done as a Corps, group or family and the questions asked as a group. i.e What foundations exists in the life of the group etc.

Off-Line Activity Saturday Morning at 10:30am

World Map – Prayer points from around the world.

On our Compass page is a picture of a world map (Appendix 2). Print one or more copies – depending on the size of your group - on A3 paper in colour.

If you are in a group maybe place the map on a noticeboard of some kind. Then provide plenty of post it notes or paper for people to write prayers for things going on around the world current issues, poverty, justice, trafficking, peace. Prayers of celebration and supplication.

Perhaps beforehand type up a list of prayer points to get people started. Place the prayer point notes on the map near the country concerned or provide some string that they can link with pins or blue tac from the prayer around the outside of the map into the country that the prayer is for. Encourage people to spread prayer worldwide.

Saturday Afternoon Prayer Activity – Away from venue Community Prayer Activity – Saturday Afternoon

- Decide what Prayer Activity your group/Corps will do
 - Maybe taking a walk in a particular neighbourhood or business area praying for families, people and/or businesses
 - Or visit significant places like schools, hospitals, police stations etc.
 - Maybe go to a park and have a picnic and pray in the park
- Decide where this will take place including any route (if required) that will be used. Provide/create a map for this. Be prepared for a wet weather option just in case.
- Create a plan to ensure the safety of all who are participating, consider fluoro TSA vests for prayer walk participants
- Create a list of prayer places and/or suggested prayers
